



## Integrating SESE - Ballina and Belleek

This series of 2 practical workshops is the culmination of a year-long integrated SESE project based on Ballina and Belleek which included, amongst others:

- Plant, animal and marine habitats
- Trees
- The journey of a river- River Moy
- The history of Ballina, Belleek Castle and Belleek Woods
- Settlements



The workshops will investigate and show practical examples of how Recount, Persuasive, Explanation Writing, Poetry, Visual Arts, Oral Language, Gaelge and Numeracy were integrated in the project, as well as the objectives covered in the relevant strands of History, Geography and Science.

**Workshop 1** - Background, Project Details

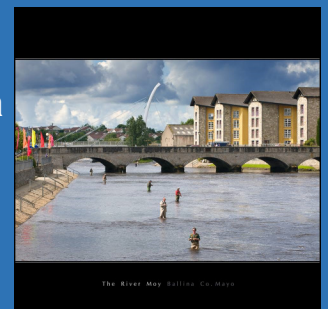
**Workshop 2** - A walk through Belleek Wood retracing the project, observing various locations of interest and marking out distance involved etc.
